



ORLEN Nations Grand Prix: five stages await the young talents

Now in its fifth year, the U23 race faces a new challenge.

There is good news for all cycling fans. In 2023, the organisers of the ORLEN Nations Grand Prix plan to dedicate five stages - instead of the classic two - to the future of the sport. On 24 May, the young U23 talents will line up at the start, together with their national teams. The winner of the competition will then be proclaimed on 28 May at the finish line at the Arłamow Hotel.

The ORLEN Nations Grand Prix is an event belonging to the prestigious UCI Nations Cup U23 series, in which the world's most talented young riders, standard-bearers for their national teams, participate.

"I remember when I participated in this race. When I think back, I still have a good feeling from those days. I was surprised by how well organised everything was and I am happy that I came back to Poland to race and win," explains Ethan Hayter, triumphant in the last Tour de Pologne.

For the ORLEN Nations Grand Prix, this will be the fifth edition. The previous one, held on 9-10 September 2022 in Podlaskie Voivodship, proclaimed Morten Nortoft the overall winner of the race. Confirming that this competition is a real springboard for future champions, the Danish rider now rides for Jumbo Visma Development.
