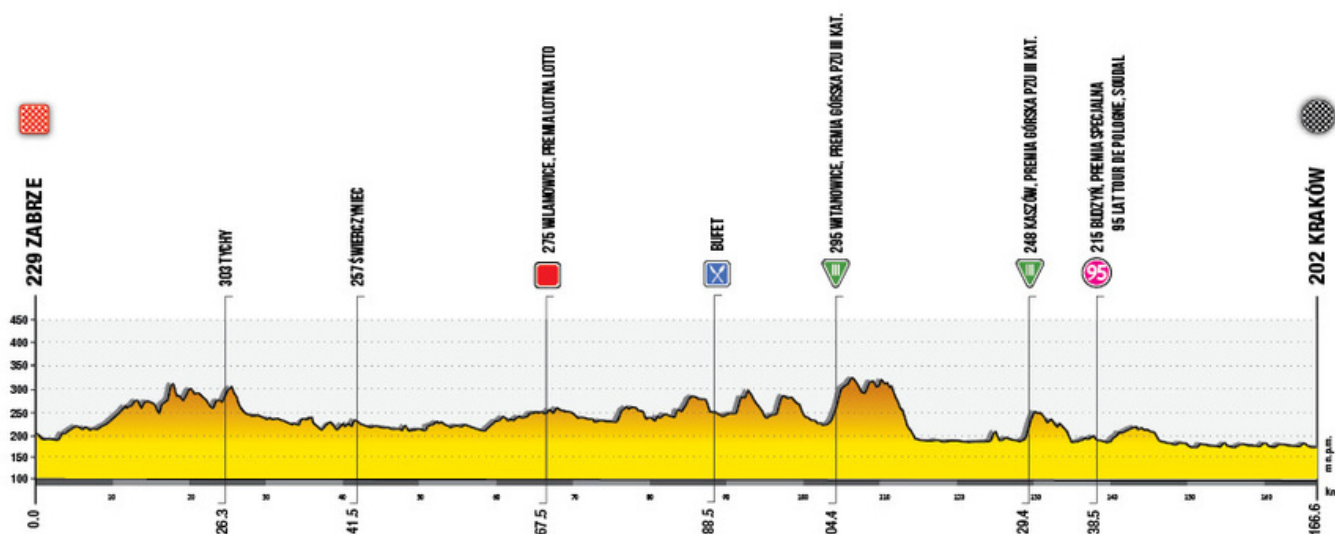


# 04.08.2023 STAGE 7 – ZABRZE – KRAKÓW / 166,6 KM

**7** 166.6 km ZABRZE - KRAKÓW

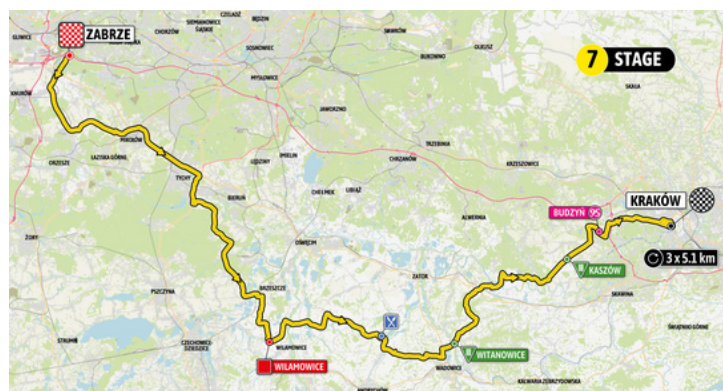

## THE STAGE

The peloton will cover almost 167 kilometres from Zabrze to Krakow, where the race traditionally ends.

The finish line will be in Krakow's Błonia after the riders have completed three laps of the circuit on the city's streets. Before arriving in Kraków, there will be the LOTTO Intermediate Finish in Wilamowice, the cat-3 PZO KOMs in Witanowice and Kaszów, and the Special Sprint SOUDAL - 95 Years of the Tour de Pologne in Budzyń. Finally, the podium ceremony for the protagonists of the 80th Tour de Pologne will take place in Krakow's Błonia.

## POINTS OF INTEREST



### Botanical Park in Zabrze

Created in 1928, the Municipal Botanical Garden wouldn't be opened to the public until 1938 because of the Great Depression.

After the war the garden was restored and repeatedly enlarged and is now more than six hectares in size, and has around thousands of specimens of plants, trees and shrubs.

A superb recent addition is the rose garden that has 2,500 individual plants from 65 varieties, bursting into colour in spring and summer. Meanwhile, In the greenhouses there are 5,000 plants from climate zones across the planet, including a wealth of palms, ferns and succulents.

And out on the paths the species are just as diverse, such as: Chinese Amur cork trees, tulip trees and Canadian hemlock.

### Krakow

Krakow is home to Poland's oldest university, Europe's largest market square in medieval times, or the second-largest Polish castle, among many other attractions. Krakow's Old Town was included on the UNESCO World Heritage List for its great historical and cultural value.

For over a hundred years (1795-1918), Krakow was part of Austria-Hungary and you still can see clearly the influence of the Habsburg Empire there. There is also a lot of visible Jewish heritage that you can see and experience especially in the Kazimierz district.
