

Everything is ready in Pomarance for GeoGravel Tuscany 2024

From Friday, 31st May to Sunday, 2nd June, Paolo Bettini's gravel event will be held in Pomarance, with 4 routes, music, parties, and great guests all there to discover Tuscany's unique geothermal area

Everything is ready in Pomarance (PI) for the second edition of GeoGravel Tuscany.

The gravel event from Paolo Bettini on the roads of Tuscany's geothermal area will officially be inaugurated today at 6 p.m. at [Piazzone di Pomarance](#) with the opening of the GeoVillage, the event's headquarters, where it will be possible to register, collect race packs (or rather the GeoMusette, because GeoGravel Tuscany is not a race) and tonight enjoy live music with performances by local bands *I matti delle Giuncaie + Caste - Gualtiero Woz Simone*.

Tomorrow, **Saturday 1st June, at 3 p.m.**, the first of the four planned routes, the **250 km Ultra**, will start, followed in the evening by the big party open with the concert by Saturnino, who will set the Piazzone ablaze with his sound and give the right charge to those starting on the morning of **Sunday 2nd June** for the **Long, Medium and Short** routes, of **110, 77 and 46 km** respectively.

Online registration will be open until midnight on Friday 31st May, after which it will be possible to register on site until 09:00 on Sunday 2nd June.

Of course, there will be no shortage of local food and wine products throughout the weekend, prepared directly in the Piazzone and served under the marquee erected for the occasion.

The GeoGravel Tuscany will be a weekend of sport, celebration and sharing, in which all registered participants will also be able to experience the unique thrill of cycling with names that have made cycling history and not only, such as the 'Lion of Flanders' **Johan Museeuw**, the CT of the National Team **Daniele Bennati** the three-time Italian champion **Giovanni Visconti**, the cobbled specialist **Luca Paolini** and finally **Paolo Kessisoglu**, a Genoese presenter and comedian who has been a cycling enthusiast for many years and after having already been present at the first edition decided to return again this year, this time together with his association '[C'è Da Fare](#)', set up to support young people in psychological distress.

All that remains is to make an appointment for everyone starting tonight in Pomarance, for three days of celebration, sharing and sport to discover a unique territory such as the Tuscan geothermal area, and to enjoy the magical atmosphere of GeoGravel Tuscany all together.

GeoGravel Tuscany is more than just a two-day sporting event, it is a real gravel festival set up to discover the Colline Metallifere and Tuscan geothermal energy. The event will begin on Friday 31st May in the afternoon with the inauguration of the GeoVillage in the "Piazzone", a beautiful area near the centre of Pomarance (PI) that will host the GeoFestival, the heart of the whole event, where there will be concerts in the evening and a wide selection of local food and wine stalls as well as speciality shops. This is also the starting point for the various rides scheduled for Saturday 1st June (ultra route) and Sunday 2nd June (long, medium and short routes).
