

## **The complete programme of GeoGravel Tuscany 2024**

On Friday 31st May, in Pomarance (PI), the second edition of GeoGravel Tuscany, the gravel event conceived by Paolo Bettini on the roads of the Tuscan geothermal area, will be launched.
