During the event, the first batch of a fully branded fleet of over 20 vehicles was officially handed over, which in just a few days will hit the road to support the race's organization.

During the event, details were also presented regarding this year's edition of the ORLEN Nations Grand Prix, which will take place in four stages across the Podkarpacie region from May 14–17.
