In a new chapter of collaboration, EKOÏ will supply the leader jerseys for the 2025 Tour de Pologne UCI WorldTour, the ORLEN Tour de Pologne Amatorów, and other Lang Team races.

These high-performance garments, including race jerseys, podium versions and time trial suits, are engineered with cutting-edge materials to deliver superior comfort, aerodynamics and technical precision.
