Reunited to honor sport and the landscapes that inspire it

Trentino is an Italian region that has supported Poland's largest cycling race for many years and is passionate about sports and cycling. It serves as a stage for professional competitions and is a popular vacation destination for Polish tourists.

The region is renowned for its passion for cycling and is the partner of the 82nd Tour de Pologne UCI WorldTour. In 2013, the Polish race began in Rovereto, with Italian stages ending in Madonna di Campiglio and Passo Pordoi. Trentino remains deeply committed to promoting sports, especially cycling.

It is one of the key locations on the cycling map of Europe. It regularly hosts stages of the Giro d'Italia and was also part of the Giro d'Italia Women this year. Trentino's routes are also used for the UCI MTB World Cup and various amateur events, including the Comano Gravel Experience, Tesino Lagorai Bike, and Alpine Gravel Val di Sole.

Poland is an important tourism market for Trentino, both in winter and, increasingly, in summer. The region offers over 465 kilometers of well-marked cycling routes that are appreciated for their landscapes and infrastructure. It's an ideal destination for professionals and all lovers of cycling and active recreation.
