On Friday, September 5th in Misano, the world champion will unveil, for the first time, the bike he'll ride in the Gravel Burn and the new technical jersey designed by Q36.5.

And thanks to our collaboration with Q36.5, I'll be wearing a technical jersey that embodies the same philosophy: essential, high-performing, and built to endure.
