## Tour de Pologne Women 2026: "They Set the Pace"

*The great celebration of women's cycling will return in July 2026. For the fourth time, female riders from Poland and around the world will compete in the increasingly prestigious Tour de Pologne Women. This year, the race organized by Lang Team will take place with a UCI ProSeries ranking, and there will be no shortage of top-division teams at the start. From July 24 to 26, female cyclists will compete on the roads of the Lubelskie Voivodeship.*

Interest in women's cycling grows year by year. The calendar is filling up systematically, and female riders are attracting crowds of fans to the routes and millions of viewers to their televisions. The increase in the popularity of women's cycling is also visible in Poland and is due in part to the White-and-Reds' excellent results on the international stage.

Among the numerous Polish women in the top teams are **Katarzyna Niewiadoma-Phinney**, **Dominika Włodarczyk**, and **Daria Pikulik**, who are among the world's leading riders. Polish women regularly compete for victories in major races, demonstrating their status as a dominant force in the women's peloton.

It's no surprise, then, that Poland's largest women's race, the **Tour de Pologne Women**, is growing every year. Reactivated by Czesław Lang and Lang Team in 2024, the competition will now take place for the **fourth time**. With each passing year, the race ascends the cycling ladder — this year, the event will be held under the prestigious UCI ProSeries banner.

Thanks to this, the leading teams and female cyclists, including the Polish women, will be in Poland again. This year's race, with the slogan "They Set the Pace," will visit the Lubelskie Voivodeship again. From July 24-26, the riders will compete for the yellow jersey of the **ORLEN** General Classification leader, the race's main sponsor, as well as the blue jersey of the **LOTTO** Most Active Rider.

Thanks to the professional television broadcast, which will be aired live and in replays on Telewizja Polska, Eurosport, and the HBO Max streaming platform, the race will once again showcase Poland and the region, which abounds with picturesque spots that the peloton will visit. With a star-studded cast, Polish female riders, and beautiful landscapes, this is a spectacle that cannot be missed.
